### PRESIDENT'S CORNER

This month we are very fortunate to have Scott Joslove, President and CEO of the Texas Hotel and Lodging Association, give us an update on the results of the recent Texas Legislative sessions. I had the opportunity to hear Scott give a similar report a couple of weeks ago and while Scott represents all of Texas, he pointed out several key pieces of legislation that directly affected many hotels in Tarrant County. So when I received our hotel's bill for THLA dues, it made me think about the HUGE return on investment we received from just this year's efforts. Scott will tell us



about the change in alcoholic beverage tax which will save our one hotel over \$50,000 in taxes next year. That is a 20 times return on investment for just one year. When Scott has completed his recap, you can count the thousands of dollars the THLA representation has had on both direct and indirect savings.

The annual THLA & HATC dues are a very worthwhile expense for every hotel in Tarrant County so please join or renew as soon as you can. On the local level, in February, our Executive Director, Julie Faver-Dylla, represented HATC at city hall to protect Hotel Occupancy tax from funding for the Fort Worth Arts. While we do support funding for The Arts, we do oppose taking the money out of the occupancy tax fund to do it, as it would reduce the amount of funding for the Fort Worth Convention and Visitor's Bureau to promote and represent our hotels. Due to her efforts, we were successful in gaining full funding for the CVB.

In August, the Hotel Association of Tarrant County conducted a search for an Associate Manager to assist Julie with membership recruiting, sponsorships, online advertising and events. We are proud to announce that Claire Smith joined Julie's team in August and brings an extensive local hotel sales background to the association. This gives us twice the power to help grow our association for 2014.

We have to continuously thank our Sponsors and Allied Members by using their services whenever possible. They are to thank for our ability to award scholarships, sponsor a student chapter at the University of North Texas, have great networking receptions and luncheons, and host fantastic events like the golf tournament and casino night.

We have a wide variety of sponsors who are eager to earn your business and, in my experience, because they are members, they stand behind their work and do a great job.
