What employees are eligible?

- Employees whose performance is affected by a physical or mental impairment
- Employees whose job is in jeopardy due to a physical or mental impairment
- Employees on disability-related leave who are ready to return to work

- Job skills are retained and company benefits and seniority are maintained
- Employees are less likely to experience secondary complications such as depression that may delay or complicate recovery
- Permanent disability associated with the injury is reduced, requiring less medical care and medication
- Employee's lifestyle is maintained, and financial difficulties are avoided
